



El Salvador

Dates:

July 22nd – July 29th and required to be a part of the St. Louis Project July 12th-19th

Leaving Monday morning from St. Louis airport and arriving that evening in San Salvador, El Salvador.

Returning on July 29th in St. Louis (approximately in the morning).

Trip Cost:

\$1,450.00 (includes airfare, meals in country, ministry supplies, in country transportation, and lodging.) There is a \$25.00 registration fee due with the application. Students are also required to attend the St. Louis Project (July 12th-19th), unless they have participated within the last year. The Project cost for El Salvador participants is reduced (from 225.00) to \$100.00. Total cost for the El Salvador Mission Trip, St. Louis Project and registration fee is \$1,575.00

Important Dates

April 1st –Applications due plus a \$25.00 registration fee. (This is over the trip cost and will be used for training expenses.)

April 25th –\$150.00 of trip cost is due.(\$175.00 turned in at this time.) April 27th – Training Day, online or in person at Villa Ridge, MO

May 13th – \$800.00 of the trip cost is due used to secure airfare (\$975.00 turned in at this time.)

June 10th – 250.00 of trip cost due (\$1,225 turned in at this time.)

June 24th – \$250.00 of trip cost due (\$1,475.00 turned in at this time.)

July 12th – \$100.00 due for those attending the St. Louis Project (\$1,575.00 turned in at this time.)

July 12th – 19th St. Louis Project/El Salvador Training

July 21st – Participates arrive at the Ridge Church in Villa Ridge by 6:30 pm for final training and packing.

Objective

We will be doing VBS in the city of Chalchuapa and in mountain villages north from the city. We will also be doing youth rallies in the same locations. Students will be working together to develop their own lessons based from the Creation to the Church story sets. Other ministry will include youth leader training, pastor training (conducted by the adult leadership), church ministry, sports ministry, and door-to-door evangelism.

We will be visiting coffee plantations, the black sand beach, Mayan ruins, and shopping in a market for souvenirs.

Requirements/Expectations

Completed and approved application (includes testimony, Christian life questions, health questions, etc.)

Age requirements: 16 and over at time of travel or 14 and over if accompanied with an adult or guardian.

Cover all costs, including trip, passport (a passport is required), and immunizations. Participate in all trainings. Complete all assignments: testimony sharing, learning C to C story (Creation to Church), VBS lessons, and team projects.
